





INSTALLATION NOTES

The TXGM19D10 is designed to mount under the rear seat of GM Crew Cab Trucks.

- Some installation steps are more easily completed with a second person.
- Speaker wire is required.
- Final enclosure impedance: 2ohms.
- Recommended amplifier rating: 600-1,400 watts @ 2ohms.

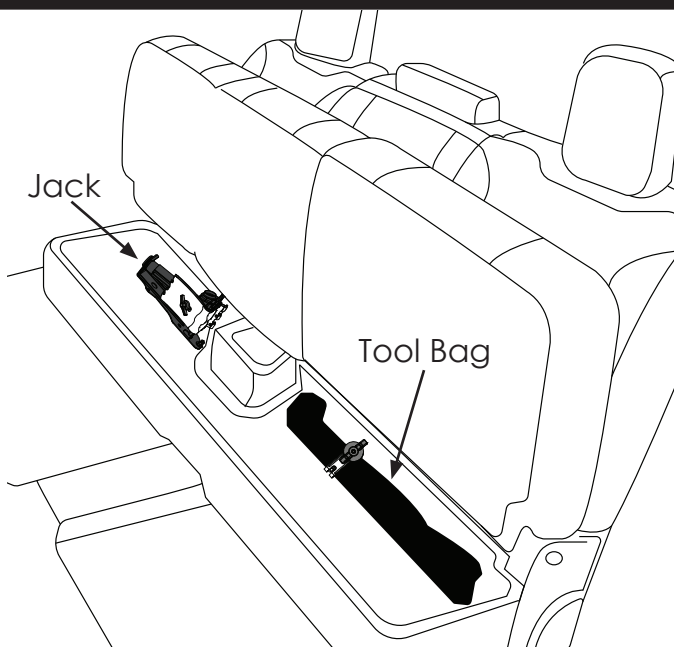

Step 1

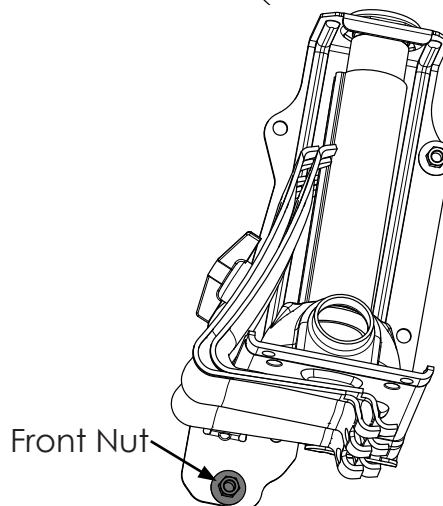
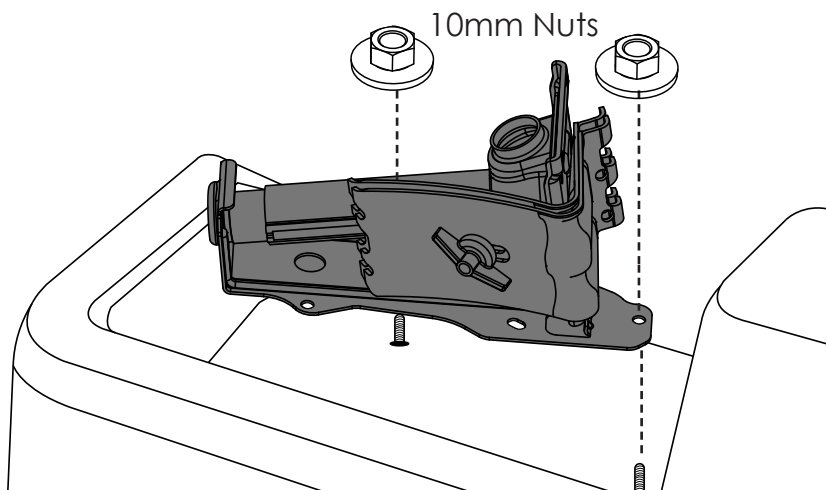
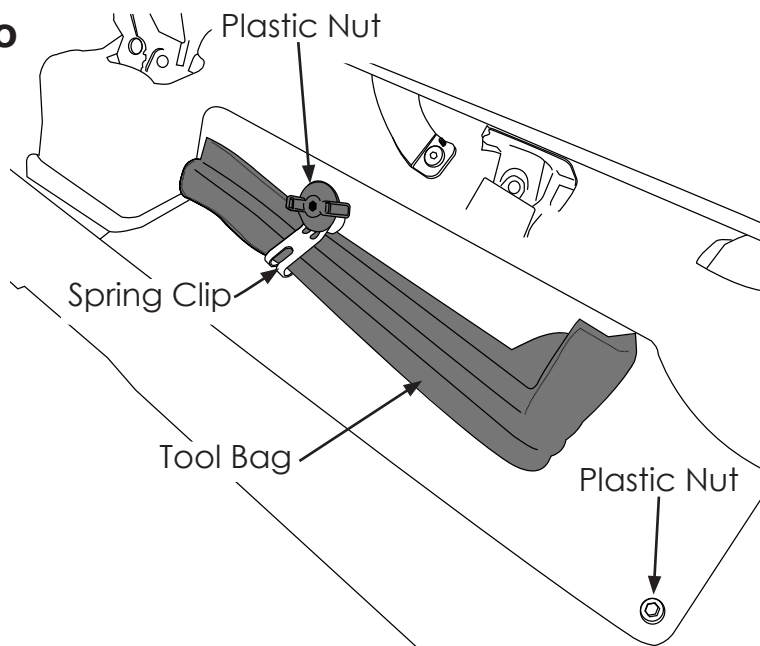
Lift up the Rear seat to expose the jack and the tool bag.



Step 2 (Skip this step if there is no storage tray)

Locate the plastic nut holding the tool bag in place. Remove the plastic nut and keep in a secure location for assembly later. Remove the tool bag and spring clip and set aside. Locate the plastic nut on the front left corner of the storage tray. With a 10mm socket remove the plastic nut.

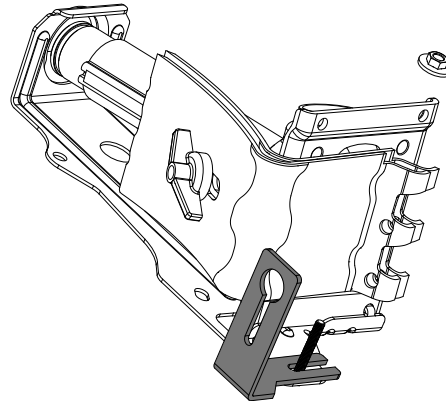
With a 10mm socket, remove the 2 nuts holding the jack in place. Place the 2 nuts in a secure location as they will be needed to remount the jack. Lift straight up and remove the Jack. Remove the storage tray. Reinstall the Jack.

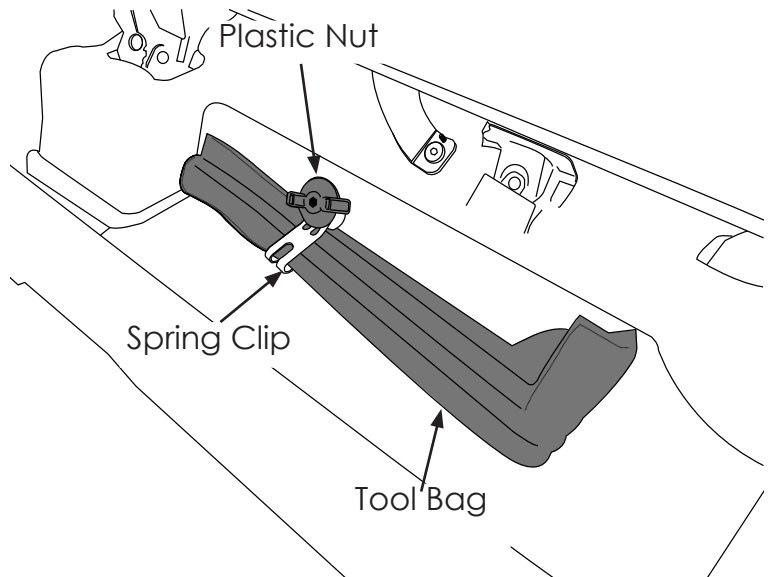
Step 3

Remove the nut located on the front side of the jack using a 10mm socket. Slide the P bracket onto the stud. Attach the nut back onto the stud leaving the P bracket able to slide for assembly later.



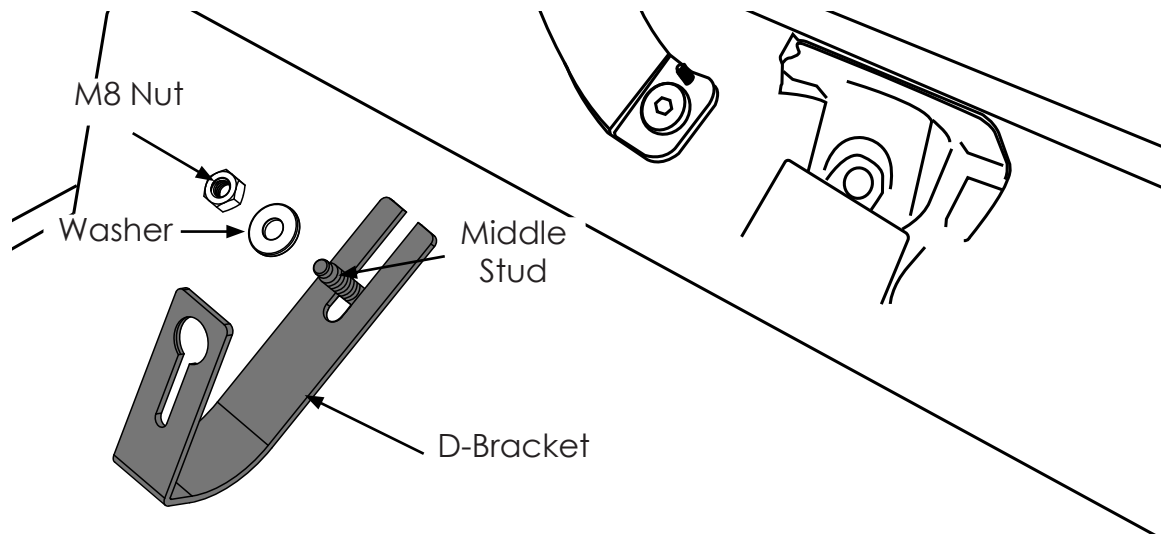
Step 4 (Skip this step if there is a storage tray)

Locate the plastic nut holding the tool bag in place. Remove the plastic nut and keep in a secure location for assembly later. Remove the tool bag and spring clip and set aside.



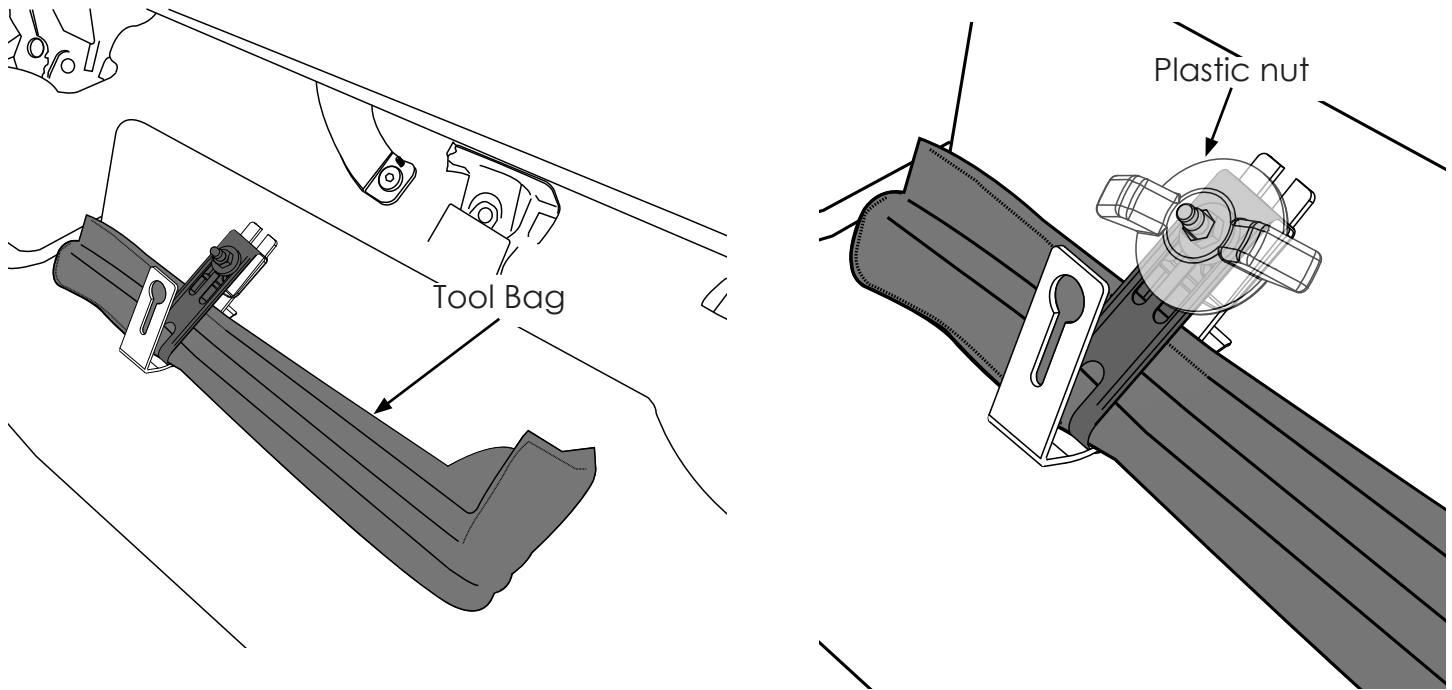
Step 5

Attach the D bracket to the middle stud. Use the supplied M8 nut and washer to mount the bracket. Tighten the nut using a 13mm socket.



Step 6

Reinstall the tool bag with spring clip onto the middle stud, using the plastic nut.



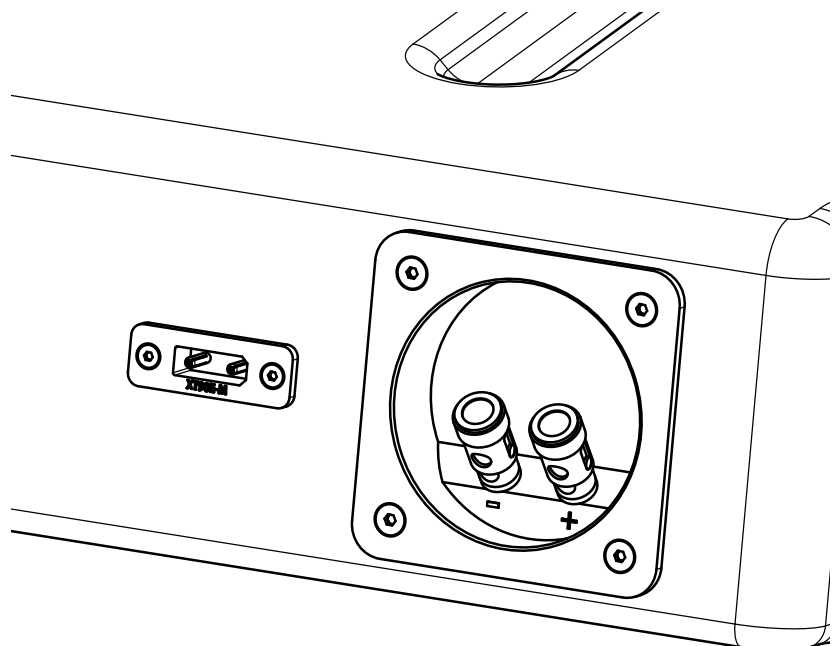
Step 7

Place the speaker enclosure in the vehicle with the rear of the enclosure facing the back seat.

Route speaker wire to the rear of the enclosure and connect using either the Push Terminals or the Quick-Plug connector.

Red = Positive (+)
Black = Negative (-)

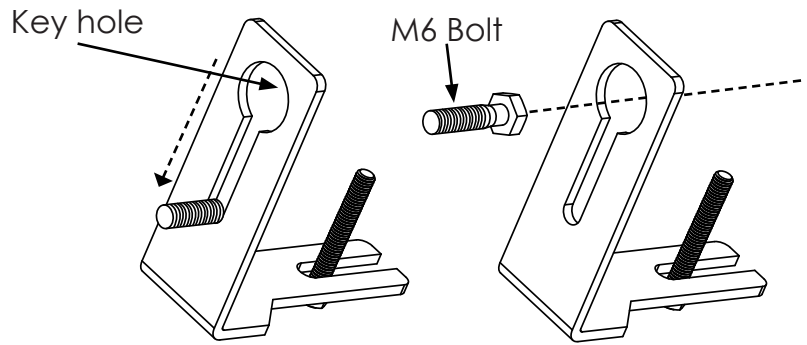
NOTE: Do not connect speaker leads to both of the enclosure connections. Use one or the other.



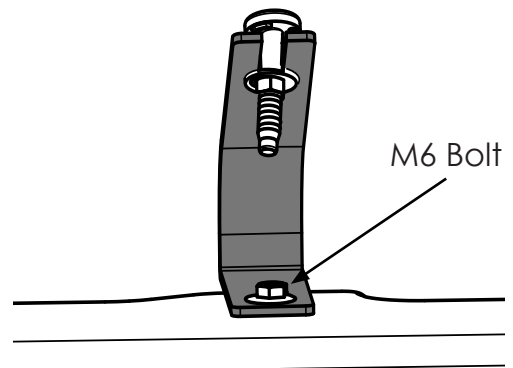
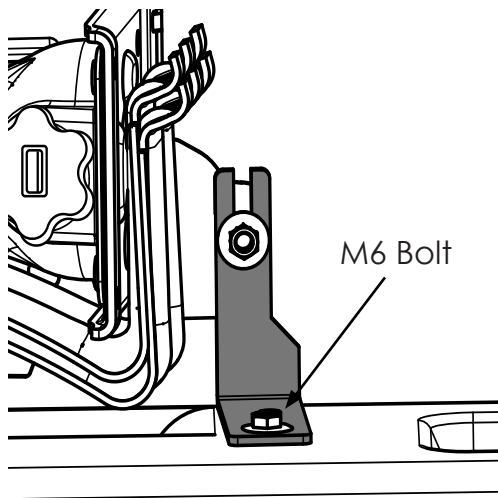
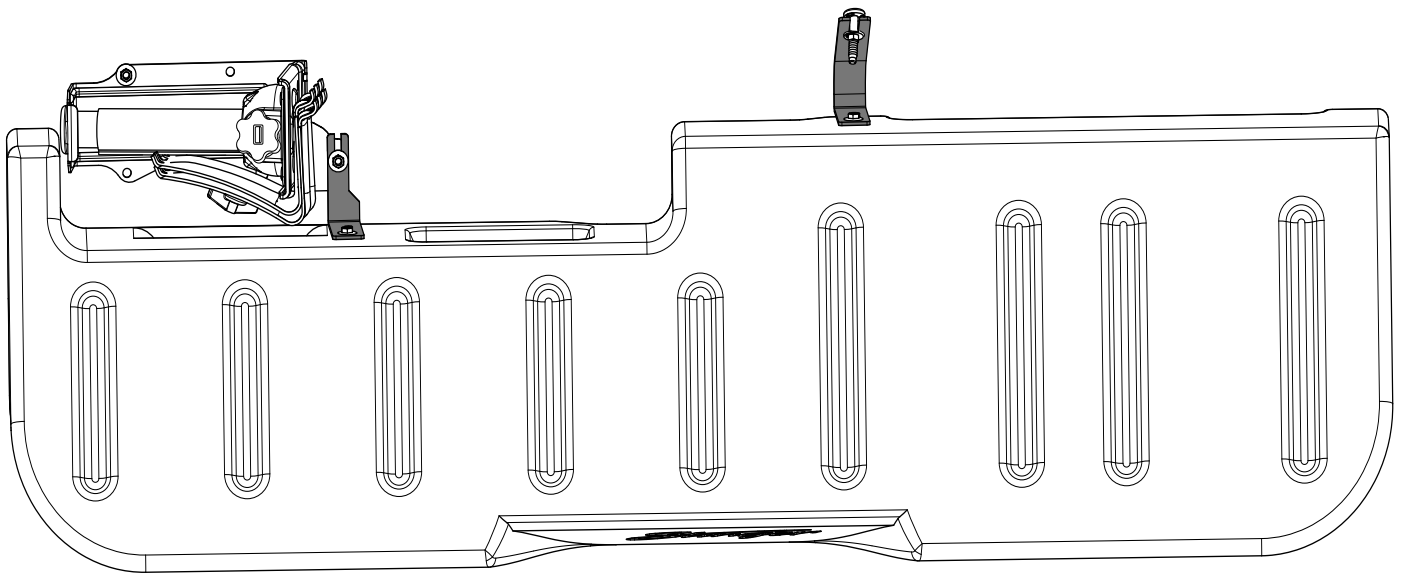
INSTALLATION

Step 8

Install the 2 M6 hex bolts into the back of the enclosure. Slide the enclosure so the 2 bolts line up with the key holes D and P brackets. Once the enclosure is in place, push down on the enclosure. With a 10mm socket, tighten the nut on the front of the jack. With a 10mm socket or wrench tighten the 2 hex bolts on the back of the enclosure.

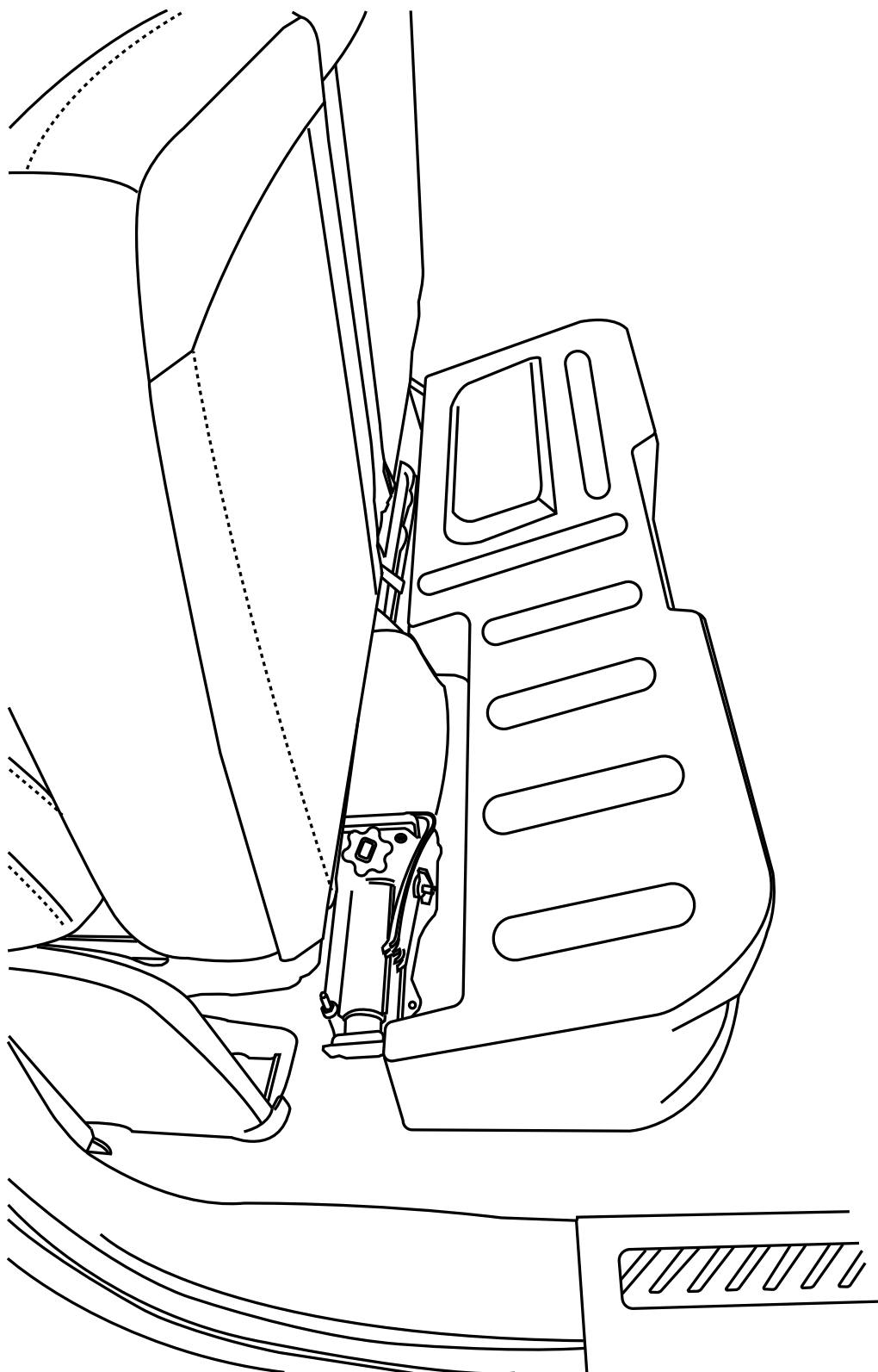


Picture to show key hole and bolt

Crank up the volume.

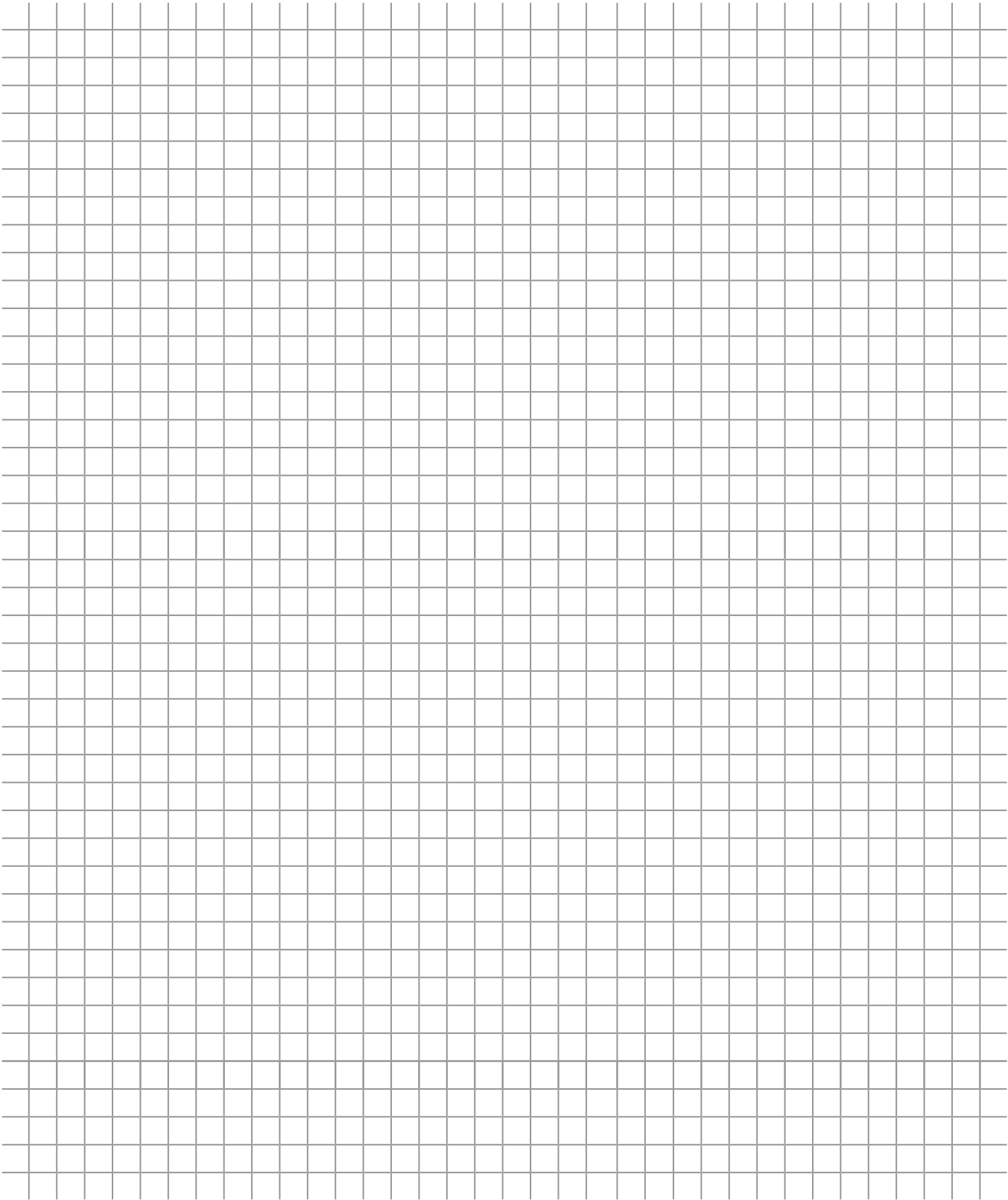

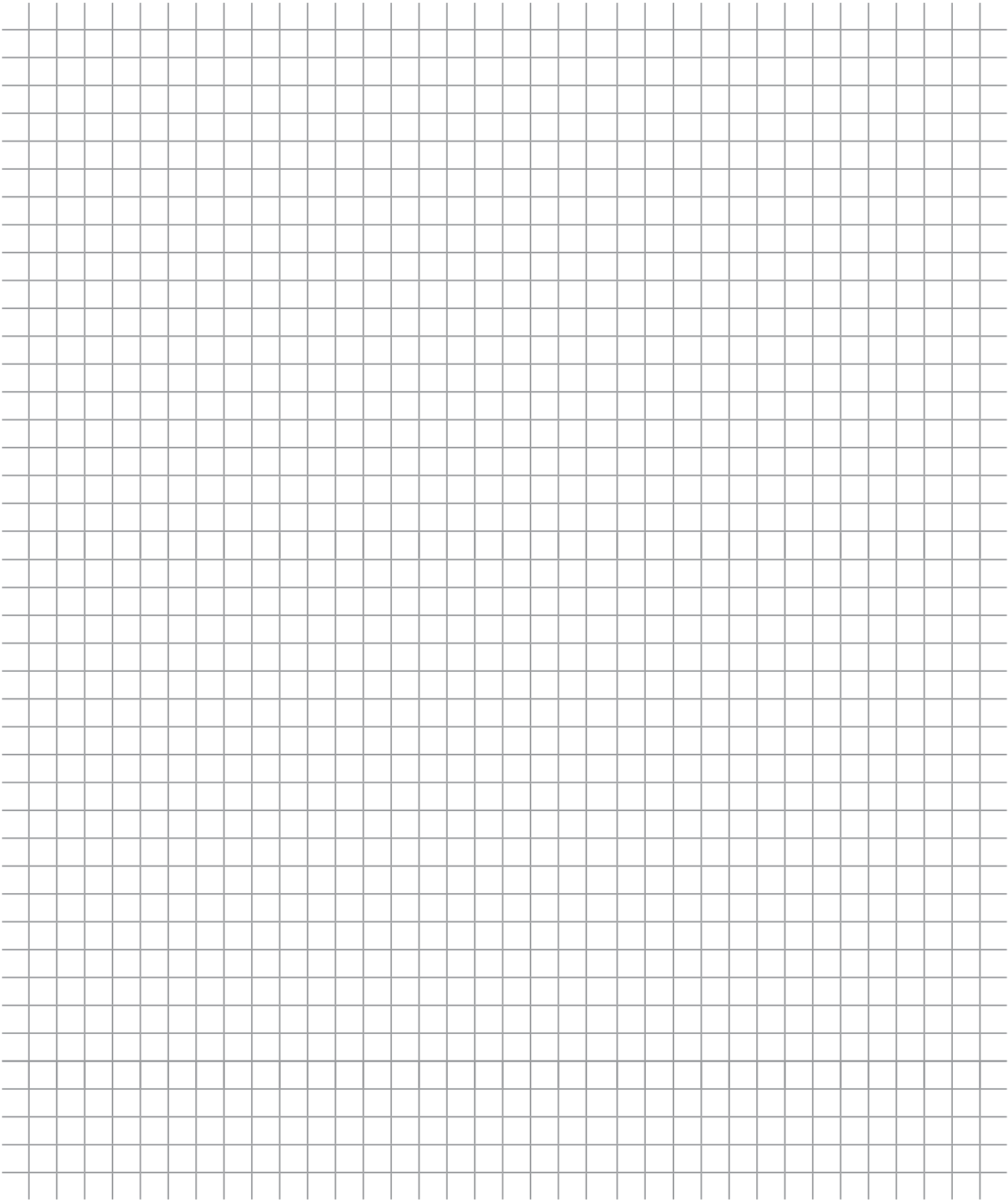
Limited Warranty

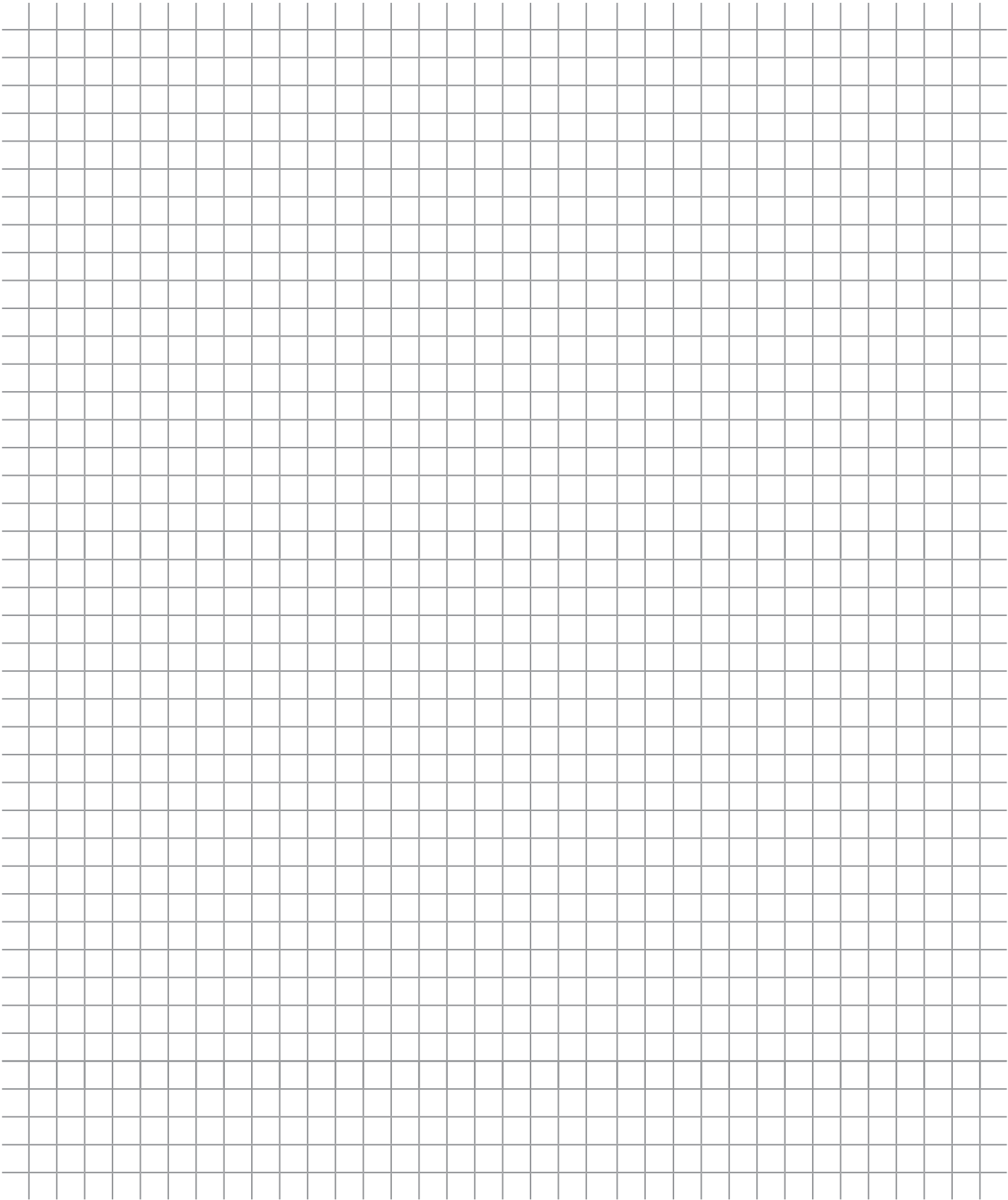
