## Precautions

### ▲ WARNINGS

#### ■ To prevent injury or fire, take the following precautions:

- To prevent a short circuit, never put or leave any metallic objects (such as coins or metallic tools) inside the unit.
- Do not watch or fix your eyes on the unit's display when you are driving for any extended period.
- If you experience problems during installation, consult your KENWOOD dealer.

#### ■ Precautions on using this unit

- When you purchase optional accessories, check with your KENWOOD dealer to make sure that they work with your model and in your area.
- You can select a language to display menus, audio file tags, etc. See Instruction Manual.
- The Radio Broadcast Data System feature won't work in areas where the service is not supported by any broadcasting station.

#### ■ Protecting the monitor

- To protect the monitor from damage, do not operate the monitor using a ball point pen or similar tool with a sharp tip.

#### ■ Cleaning the unit

- If the faceplate of this unit is stained, wipe it with a dry soft cloth such as a silicon cloth. If the faceplate is stained badly, wipe it with a cloth moistened with neutral cleaner, then wipe it again with a clean soft dry cloth.

**NOTE**

- Applying spray cleaner directly to the unit may damage its mechanical parts. Wiping the faceplate with a hard cloth or using a volatile liquid such as thinner or alcohol may scratch the surface or erase the screened print.



## Turning on the Unit

### DMX1058XR/DMX1038S/DAX1050XR


- 1 Press the  HOME button.



The unit is turned on.

### DAX800XR/DAX800S

- 1 Touch the screen.



## Initial SETUP

Perform this setup when you use this unit first time.

- 1 Set each item as follows.



### ■ [Language]

Select the language used for the control screen and setting items. Default is "American English(en)".

- ① Touch [Language].
- ② Touch [Language Select].
- ③ Select the desired language.
- ④ Touch .

### ■ [Clock]

Sets the synchronization of the clock.

### ■ [Display & Button]

Set button illumination color, clock skin, and viewing angle.

If it is hard to see the image on the screen even, adjust the viewing angle.

- ① Touch [Display & Button].
- ② Set each item and touch .

### ■ [Camera]

Set the parameters for the camera.

- ① Touch [Camera].
- ② Set each item and touch .

### ■ [Maestro SETUP]

Access settings for the iDatalink Maestro (commercially available), including settings menus for advanced camera controls, vehicle diagnostics, OEM Settings menus, and more. (Requires installation of an iDatalink Maestro in a compatible vehicle).

### ■ [Vehicle Features]

This function requires a commercial adaptor. Consult your KENWOOD dealer for details.

### ■ [DEMO]

Set the demonstration mode. Default is "ON".

### ■ [System Configuration]

Configure the digital sound output settings. For details, see **System Configuration settings (P.7)**.


- 2 Touch [Finish].

### NOTE

- When configuring the [Fiber Optic Output] and [Installation Orientation], the system will restart after the [Finish] button is pressed.

## System Configuration settings

- 1 Touch [System Configuration] on the Initial SETUP screen.



### ■ [Fiber Optic Output] (DMX1058XR/DAX1050XR/DAX800XR only)

Set the output sampling frequency when using optical digital sound output.

## Getting Started

- ① Touch [Fiber Optic Output].
- ② Select the output sampling frequency.  
[OFF] (Default) / [48kHz] / [96kHz]
- ③ Touch .  
Touch [Finish] and a message will appear.  
Touch [Yes] to restart and apply the settings.

### ■ [X'over Network]

Set X'over Network to either 2-way or 3-way.

- ① Touch [X'over Network].
- ② Read the message and press [Next].
- ③ Select the crossover network mode.  
[2way] (Default) / [3way]
- ④ Touch [Yes].

### ▲ CAUTION

Connecting 3-way speakers with the 2-way mode selected can break the speakers.

### NOTE

- When installing a 3-way speaker, make sure to always first run Initialize and go through the user setup.
- X'Over Network settings are disabled when the [Fiber Optic Output] is set to 48 kHz or 96 kHz.

### ■ [Built-In Amplifier]

Select whether to use the built-in power amplifier. Turning off the built-in amplifier improves the quality of the sound from Preout.

[ON] (Default) / [OFF]

### ■ [Installation Orientation]

Set whether the main unit is oriented vertically or horizontally.

- ① Touch [Installation Orientation].
- ② Select the orientation.  
[Horizontal] (Default) / [Vertical]
- ③ Touch .

Touch [Finish] and a message will appear.  
Touch [Yes] to restart and apply the settings.

## To set up the camera assignment settings

### ■ [REAR VIEW CAMERA]

The rear camera is always connected to the rear view camera input terminals. This setting cannot be changed.

### ■ [FRONT VIEW CAMERA / DASH CAM]

Set the camera assignment from view camera connected to Front view camera/ Dashboard camera input terminal.


### ■ [3rd VIEW CAMERA]

Set the camera assignment from view camera connected to 3rd view camera input terminal.

### ■ [VIDEO IN]

Set the camera assignment from view camera connected to Video input terminal.

- 7 Select the view camera to set up.**

Displays the picture from the view camera connected to the input terminal to be set. (P.21)

### 2 Camera Position

Assign each position to the view camera connected to the selected input terminal.

Switch the mirroring setting.

# Connection/Installation

## Before Installation

Before installation of this unit, please note the following precautions.

### ▲ WARNINGS

- If you connect the ignition wire (red) and the battery wire (yellow) to the car chassis (ground), you may cause a short circuit, that in turn may start a fire. Always connect those wires to the power source running through the fuse box.
- Do not cut out the fuse from the ignition wire (red) and the battery wire (yellow). The power supply must be connected to the wires via the fuse.


### ▲ CAUTION

- Install this unit in the console of your vehicle.
- Do not touch the metal part of this unit during and shortly after the use of the unit. Metal part such as the heat sink and enclosure become hot.

### NOTE

- Mounting and wiring this product requires skills and experience. For best safety, leave the mounting and wiring work to professionals.
- Do not install the unit if it becomes an obstacle to driver performance.
- Adjust the panel position not to become an obstacle to driver performance.
- Make sure to ground the unit to a negative 12V DC power supply.
- Do not install the unit in a spot exposed to direct sunlight or excessive heat or humidity. Also avoid places with too much dust or the possibility of water splashing.
- Do not use your own screws. Use only the screws provided. If you use the wrong screws, you could damage the unit.
- If the power is not turned ON ("There is an error in the speaker wiring. Please check the connections." is displayed), the speaker wire may have a short-circuit or touched the chassis of the vehicle and the protection function may have been activated. Therefore, the speaker wire should be checked.

- If your car's ignition does not have an ACC position, connect the ignition wires to a power source that can be turned on and off with the ignition key. If you connect the ignition wire to a power source with a constant voltage supply, such as with battery wires, the battery may be drained.
- If the console has a lid, the lid will not be closed even when the unit is installed correctly.
- If the fuse blows, first make sure the wires are not touching to cause a short circuit, then replace the old fuse with one with the same rating.
- Insulate unconnected wires with vinyl tape or other similar material. To prevent a short circuit, do not remove the caps on the ends of the unconnected wires or the terminals.
- Connect the speaker wires correctly to the terminals to which they correspond. The unit may be damaged or fail to work if you share the ⊖ wires or ground them to any metal part in the car.
- When only two speakers are being connected to the system, connect the connectors either to both the front output terminals or to both the rear output terminals (do not mix front and rear). For example, if you connect the ⊕ connector of the left speaker to a front output terminal, do not connect the ⊖ connector to a rear output terminal.
- After the unit is installed, check whether the brake lamps, blinkers, wipers, etc. on the car are working properly.
- This unit has the cooling fan to decrease the internal temperature. Do not mount the unit in a place where the cooling fan of the unit is blocked. Blocking these openings will inhibit the cooling of the internal temperature and result in malfunction.




Cooling fan

- Do not press hard on the panel surface when installing the unit to the vehicle. Otherwise scars, damage, or failure may result.



Bluetooth/Wi-Fi antenna unit



● **Forward and Lateral Fields of Vision**

- To determine driver's forward and lateral fields of vision under normal conditions, place a pole (directly visible from the front or visible through the car rear-view mirror) as shown.



- : Pole (height: 1m, diameter: 0.3m)
- ▭ : Field of vision from steering position
- : Exempted area (pole size is subject to regulation)

- For right hand drive vehicles, standards are reversed.

- \*1 The pole must be visible from the driver's position as direct forward field of vision.
- \*2 The pole must be directly visible or indirectly visible through the mirror, etc. from the driver's position.

### Installation procedure

1. To prevent a short circuit, remove the key from the ignition and disconnect the ⊖ terminal of the battery.
2. Remove the vehicle parts for installing the unit and connecting wires to terminal.
3. Make the proper input and output wire connections for each unit.
4. Connect the speaker wires of the wiring harness.
5. Connect the wiring harness wires in the following order; ground, battery, ignition.
6. Determine the height of the display unit and position of the slider. See **Distance between the display unit and the main unit (P.13)**.
7. Connect the wiring harness connector to the unit.
8. Install the main unit to the vehicle.
9. Reinstall the vehicle parts.
10. Install the display unit.
11. Reconnect the ⊖ terminal of the battery.
12. Perform the Initial Setup.  
See **Initial SETUP (P.7)**.

## Installing the accessories


### GPS antenna

GPS antenna is installed inside of the car. It should be installed as horizontally as possible to allow easy reception of the GPS satellite signals.

To mount the GPS antenna inside your vehicle:

1. Clean your dashboard or other surface.
2. Remove the separator of the metal plate (accessory ⑦).
3. Press the metal plate (accessory ⑦) down firmly on your dashboard or other mounting surface. You can bend the metal plate (accessory ⑦) to conform to a curved surface, if necessary.

4. Remove the separator of the GPS antenna (accessory ⑥), and stick the antenna to the metal plate (accessory ⑦).




### NOTE

- Use the supplied GPS antenna. Using the GPS antenna other than the supplied one may cause a drop in positioning accuracy.
- Depending on the type of car, reception of the GPS satellite signals might not be possible with an inside installation.
- Please install this GPS antenna in an area away from any antennas that are used with CB radios or satellite televisions.
- The GPS antenna should be installed at a position that is spaced at least 12 inch (30 cm) from smartphone/cell-phone or other transmitting antennas. Signals from the GPS satellite may be interfered with by these types of communication.
- Painting the GPS antenna with (metallic) paint may cause a drop in performance.

### Microphone unit

1. Check the installation position of the microphone (accessory ③).
2. Clean the installation surface.
3. Remove the separator of the microphone (accessory ③), and stick the microphone to the place shown below.
4. Wire the microphone cable up to the unit with it secured at several positions using tape or other desired method.
5. Adjust the direction of the microphone (accessory ③) to the driver.

- Make sure that the unit is installed securely in place, if the unit is unstable, it may malfunction.


- Fix with hexagon head screws correctly. After installing the display unit (accessory ⑧) to the main unit, tilt the display forward until it stops and confirm that the display unit (accessory ⑧) does not hit vehicle parts. If the display unit hits vehicle parts, adjust the display height again.

- 7** Adjust the length of the display cable to align with the height of the display unit. Install it so that the display unit has room to move. Tuck the remaining display cable inside the main unit.

- 8** Attach the rear cover of the display unit. Insert the hooks on the rear cover into the grooves on the display unit. Slide it along the main unit until you hear a click.



- 9** Fix the display unit cover with two binding head screws (accessory ⑩).





## Removing the display cable

### CAUTION

- To prevent injuries to your hands and damage to the display cable, cover the metal parts with protective tape before working.
- Do not disconnect cables while the unit's power is on. Doing so could cause damage.

- 1** Apply protective tape so that it covers the metal parts in the shaded area in the image.



- 2** Press and hold the display cable lock and then remove the cable.

Disconnect the Power cable for Display (①) and Video cable for Display (②).




