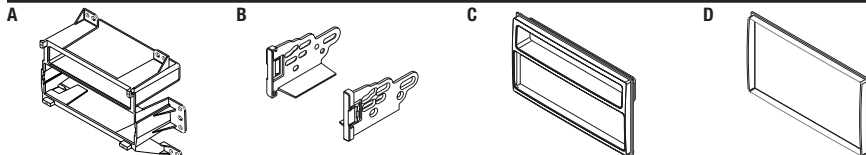

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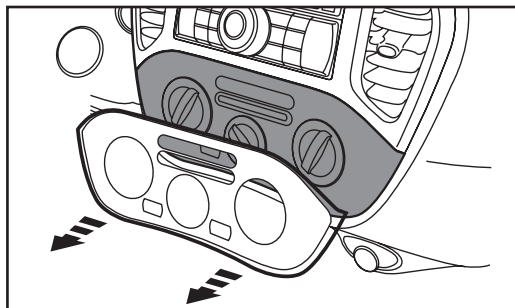

NOTE: Refer to the instructions included with the aftermarket radio.

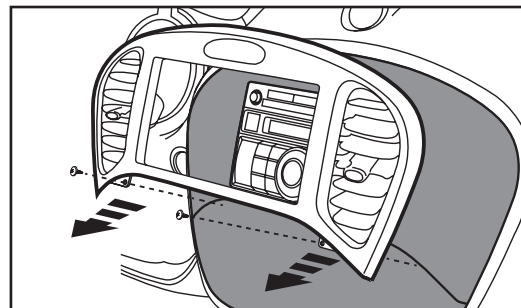
Nissan Juke 2011-2014

For manual climate controls:

1. Lift up to remove the small knob on the slide for "recirc/ fresh air".
2. Unsnap and remove the trim from around the climate controls (controls stay in the dash). (Figure A-1)
3. Remove (2) Phillips screws securing the radio trim panel. (Figure B)
4. Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio, unplug and remove radio. (Figure C)

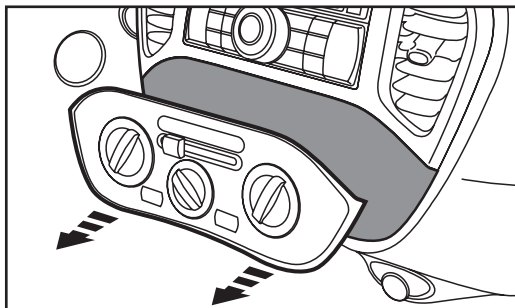

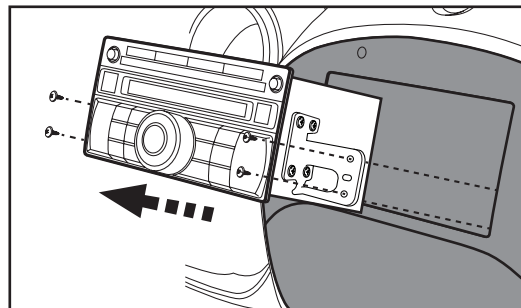

For auto climate controls:

1. Unclip and remove the climate control panel. (Figure A-2)
2. Remove (2) Phillips screws securing the radio trim panel. (Figure B)
3. Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio, unplug and remove radio. (Figure C)

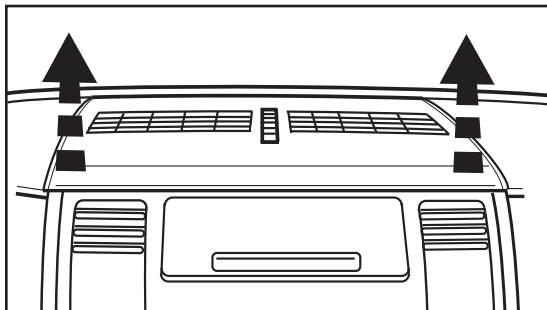

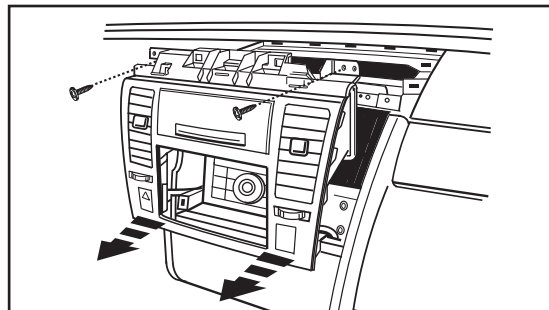
Unclip and remove the panel above the radio. (Figure A, B)

2. Remove (2) Phillips screws securing the radio trim panel then unclip and remove the entire panel surrounding the radio and A/C controls. (Figure C)
3. Remove (4) Phillips screws securing radio, unplug and remove radio. (Figure D)

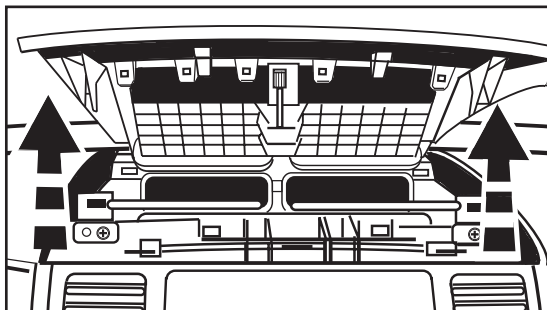

DIN radio provision with pocket

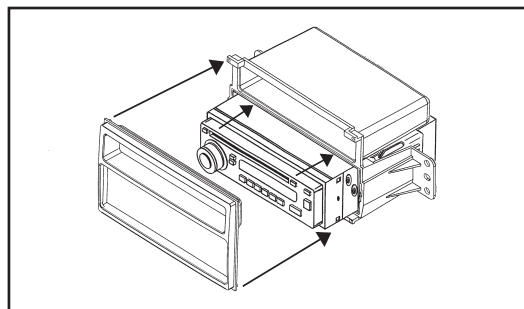
1. Cut and remove the appropriate tabs not necessary for your application. (Figure A)
2. Remove the metal "DIN" sleeve and trim ring from the aftermarket radio.
3. Slide the sleeve into the Radio Housing and secure by bending the metal locking tabs down. (Figure B)
4. Slide the radio into the sleeve until it "clicks" in. (Figure C)
5. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna plug in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapters from Metra and/or AXCESS.
6. Attach the trim plate supplied with the kit to the front of the radio housing assembly. (Figure C)
7. Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.

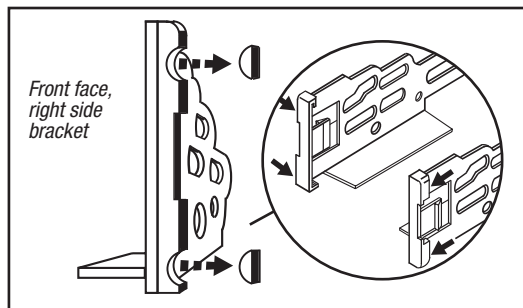

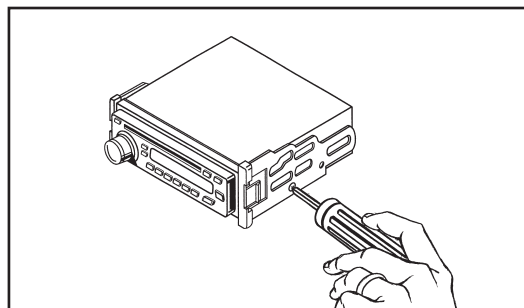
ISO DIN radio provision with pocket

Note: The following modification will need to be made to both ISO brackets when using the ISO radio provision. Cut or trim the area shown from the ISO bracket. (Figure A)

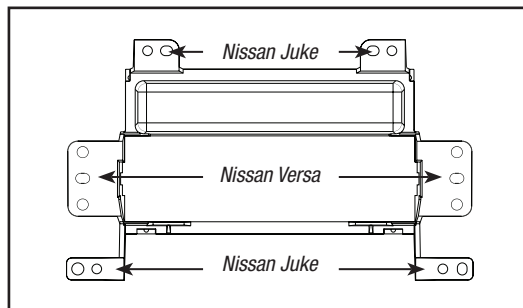
1. Cut and remove the appropriate tabs not necessary for your application. (Figure B)
2. Remove the metal "DIN" sleeve and trim ring from the aftermarket radio.
3. Mount the ISO Brackets to the aftermarket radio with the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure C)
4. Slide the radio into the radio opening until the side clips engage. (Figure D)
5. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna plug in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapters from Metra and/or AXCESS.
6. Attach the trim plate supplied with the kit to the front of the radio housing assembly. (Figure D)
7. Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.



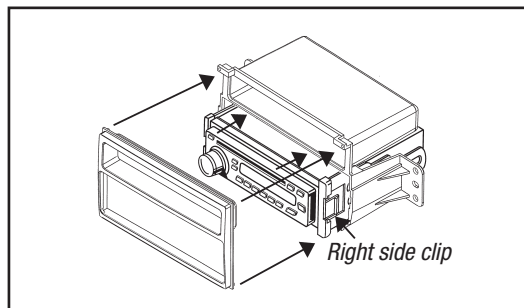

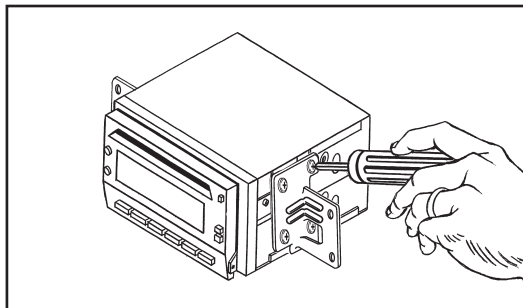

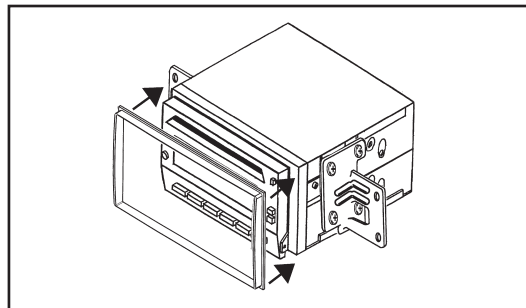

Double DIN radio provision

1. Mount the factory brackets (removed from factory radio during disassembly) to the sides of the aftermarket radio using screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
2. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna plug in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapters from Metra and/or AXCESS.
3. Place the double DIN trim plate on the front of the radio. (Figure B)
4. Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.

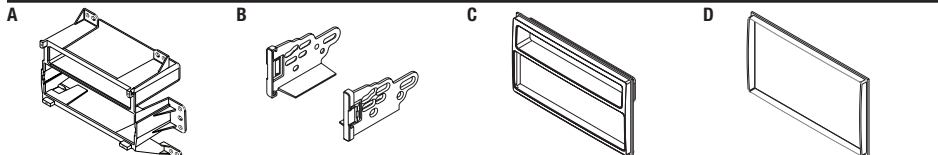

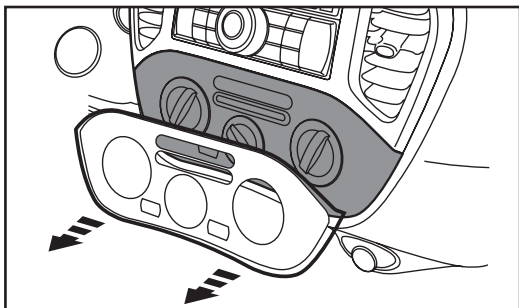
1. Levante para quitar la pequeña perilla de la corredera para "recirc / aire fresco".

4. Quite (4) tornillos Phillips que sujetan la radio, desenchufe y quite la radio. (Figura C)

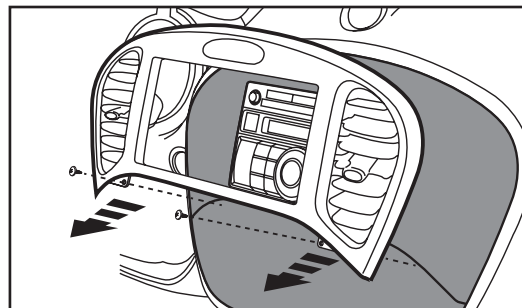

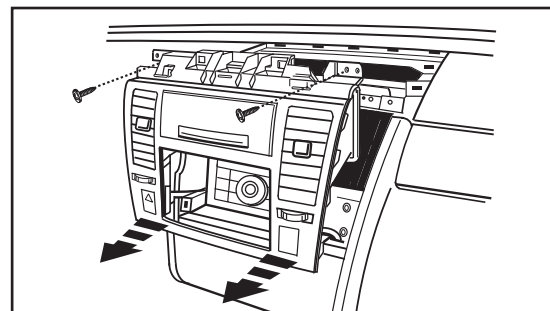
Nissan Versa 2007-2011

Provision de radio DIN con bolsillo

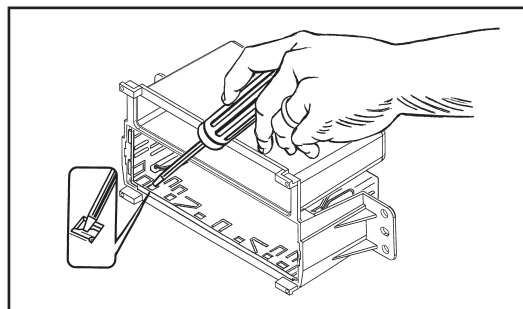
1. Corte y quite las pestañas correspondientes que no sean necesarias para su aplicación. (Figura A)
2. Retire la funda de metal "DIN" y anillo de compensación de la radio no original.
3. Deslice la carcasa del radio y sujétela doblando hacia abajo las pestañas de metal. (Figura B)
4. Deslice la unidad central de mercado secundario en la rejilla y sujétela. (Figura C)
5. Ubique el arnés de cableado de fábrica y el conector de la antena en el tablero. Metra recomienda que use adaptadores adecuados de acoplamiento de Metra y/o de AXCESS.
6. Una la placa de la moldura que viene con el kit a la parte de enfrente del conjunto de la carcasa del radio. (Figura C)

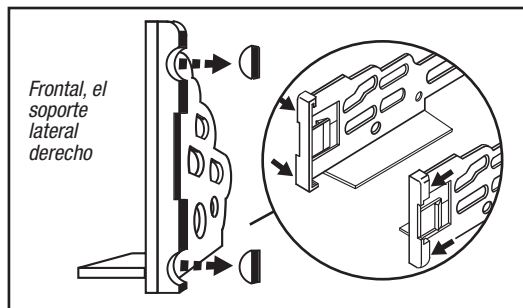

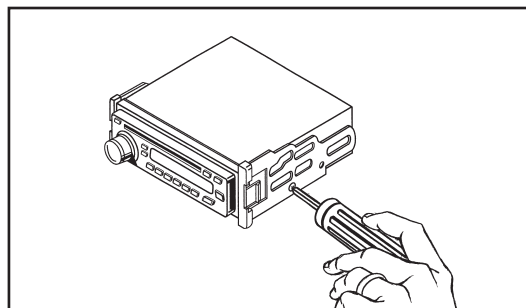
Provisión de radio ISO DIN con bolsillo

Nota: Tendrá que hacerse esta modificación a los dos soportes ISO cuando use la provisión de radio de montaje ISO. Corte o recorte el área mostrada desde el soporte ISO. (Figura A)

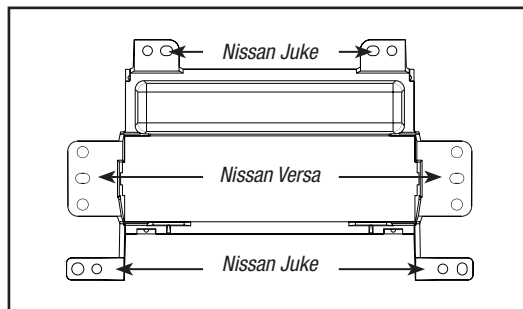
1. Corte y quite las pestañas correspondientes que no sean necesarias para su aplicación. (Figura B)
2. Retire la funda de metal "DIN" y anillo de compensación de la radio no original.
3. Monte los soportes ISO en la unidad central con los tornillos incluidos con la unidad. (Figura C)
4. Deslice la unidad central en la apertura del radio hasta que los ganchos laterales se enganchen. (Figura D)
5. Ubique el arnés de cableado de fábrica y el conector de la antena en el tablero. Metra recomienda el uso de adaptadores adecuados de acoplamiento de Metra y/o de AXESS.
6. Una la placa de la moldura que viene con el kit a la parte de enfrente del conjunto de la carcasa del radio. (Figura D)
7. Vuelva a armar el tablero al revés de como lo desarmó.



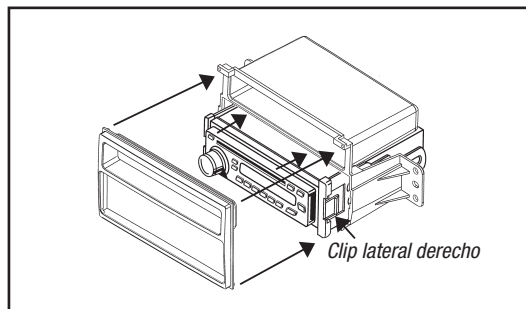

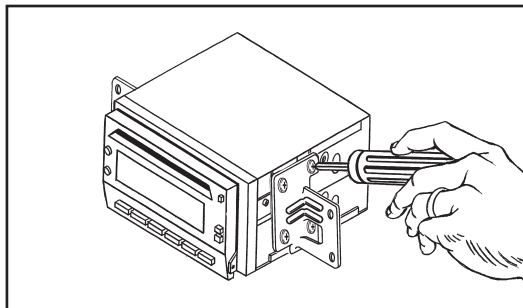

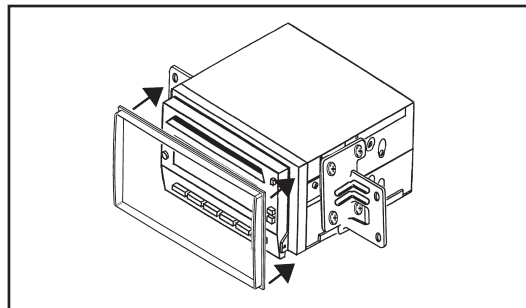

Provisión de radio doble DIN

1. Monte los soportes de fábrica (que quitó del radio de fábrica cuando lo desarmó) a los lados del radio con los tornillos que vienen con el radio doble DIN. (Figura A)
2. Ubique el arnés de cableado de fábrica y el conector de la antena en el tablero. Metra recomienda el uso de adaptadores adecuados de acoplamiento de Metra y/o de AXCESS.
3. Coloque la placa de moldura DDIN en la parte de enfrente del radio. (Figura B)
4. Vuelva a armar el tablero al revés de como lo desarmó.
